Electric car sharing service makes its way to Kern and Tulare counties

BAKERSFIELD, Calif. (KBAK/KBFX) — Miocar, the electric vehicle car sharing service, is now available in Kern and Tulare counties.

The service will provide residents affordable access to vehicles that can be rented on an hourly or daily basis online or via a smartphone mobile app.

Miocar uses 100 percent electric vehicles, which help reduce air pollution by emitting less greenhouse gases compared to conventional vehicles.

The rates for the service are \$4 per hour or \$35 per day and \$45 per day on weekends.

“Whether you are a parent who uses the only car for work, leaving the rest of the family in need of a second vehicle during the day or if you don’t own a vehicle and need one for an out-of-town appointment— this service can help,” said Abigail Solis, senior community development specialist for Self Help Enterprises via a press release.

Anyone wanting to use this service can download the Miocar smartphone app available on the Apple App Store or Google Play to start the process.

The vehicles are parked at charging stations installed at SHE residential complexes in Dinuba, Orosi, Visalia, Wasco and Arvin, where they are available to reserve and pick up 24/7.
