Self-Help Enterprises (SHE) is pleased to announce the availability of competitive academic scholarships from the Doris “Do” Dooley Scholarship Fund.

SHE has been the sponsor of many projects in your area, and this scholarship is available to students from families that have participated in SHE programs. SHE projects include Rental Housing, Self-Help Housing, Housing Rehabilitation, Community Development and others. **The student’s family must have participated in one of Self-Help Enterprises’ programs.**

SHE’s Scholarship Program is available to students who plan to enroll full time (12 units or more) in a vocational or trade school, community college or four-year university. **Scholarship recipients must submit verification of enrollment prior to disbursement of funds.**

The following must be **received** by **Friday, March 12, 2021**:

- The attached scholarship application form;
- A 1-2 page essay discussing family background, future goals and aspirations, and how the scholarship award will help achieve those goals;
- A copy of the high school or college transcript; and
- Two letters of recommendation

The SHE Scholarship Committee, comprised of members of SHE’s Board of Directors, will make the final selection. An announcement of the scholarship awards will be sent to the recipient student’s home. It is the responsibility of each interested student to mail completed applications to:
